Swedish stove wins international design award.

This was in competition with 57 countries and a total of 4252 products after thorough evaluation by an international jury of experts. The "Red dot quality label for high design quality" prize is an award for outstanding and innovative design in one of the most prestigious and competitive design competitions in the world.

"Every product that has won a Red dot design award has had to convince an international jury of experts of its quality. The products stand out from the crowd with their excellent design and newly created appearance and have shown their quality in one of the toughest design competitions in the world", explains Professor Peter Zec, the man behind the Red dot design award.

Tall soapstone stove

The Handöl 35T is an experience, lit or unlit, an efficient and environmentally marked stove with an 80% efficiency rating. A union of discreet Scandinavian interior design, real fire and scientifically optimised energy management.

The raised position of the firebox and the tall glass sections elevate the fire, which increases the visual impact in the room. The height also means more ergonomic wood filling and ash removal.

The awards ceremony will be held on 5th July in Essen, European City of Culture 2010, in Germany. Thereafter, the design award winners will be exhibited at the Red dot design museum in the "Design on stage" exhibition until 1st August 2011.
